Long memorial hall address is incorrect with North Yorkshire County Council (NYCC) NYCC There is an issue with the historical bank details that we have been paying to. Final demand of £3984 requested, but to confirm exactly how much we have paid already. NYCC need like a standing order setting up. Action Cllr Geddes

Whinney Lane Developments. Cllrs decided this did not need discussing as it's not a development in our Parish.

Cllr Paraskos asked about the audit exemptions for councils with a turnover of more than £25,000, YCLA will be able to advise on the figures. Clerk to contact YCLA to confirm.

Progress with Doctors Surgery:

Asbestos and epc completed.

Lease not signed, our solicitor has written to Cllr Geddes to notify that there is paperwork to sign.

Cllr Geddes meeting with the doctors on 19.06.2024.

Cllr Marston to organise the repointing on the wall outside the old kitchen both above and below the bay window. URGENT. Damp above and below the window.

Pharmabox is being installed between 8th and 10th July.

After installation the builder will return to put the bollards in place for Doctor's parking and in front of Pharmabox.

Lamp post light is bright orange near a member of the public's house in the village, can the bulb be changed? Cllr Paraskos advised it will only be changed if the light breaks but advised that the light replacement is very bright!

Concerns have been raised to the Parish Council regarding parked cars in potentially hazardous locations. To refer to North Yorkshire Police to review. Action Clerk.

Monday Monkeys are struggling financially. Parish Council are going to give a donation to help. This is a very important non profit making service to the village. This donation will come from the contents of the collection tin at Spofforth Deli and Post Office. Action Cllr Geddes.

Cheque received for £700 from the Youth Club as the group has disbanded. This is to go towards a new piece of playground equipment that is accessible to all. Gratefully received. Action Clerk.

The Cllrs would like to invite a Governor from the school to come to the July meeting to give an update as we'd like to work with the school more. Action Cllr Marston.
