There is overhanging foliage on the footpaths at the Old Mill – Council gave permission for parishioners to attend to it themselves.

Coun. Paraskos reminded Council about the submission of annual accounts - Coun. Geddes confirmed that Rachel Marston is assisting in the process.

The trees on the banking at the end of Beech Lane are again out of control – Coun. Paraskos will report to NYCC and to housing as the gardens are very dark with the height of the trees.

Trees have been removed from the Railway Embankment at Bridge Cottage at the Cricket Club. Coun. Paraskos will report to the Enforcement Officer.

There have been complaints from parishioners regarding the overhanging foliage from the Old Rectory on Wetherby Road and from the last house on the left directly opposite the shop. It is difficult at this time of year with birds nesting to take any action, but Council will write and ask if it could be attended to in September. There is also a house on School Lane which is almost impossible to pass - Coun. Moore will mention.

The Insurance for the Village Hall has been with Zurich Insurance for over 10 years and this year renewal is standing at £4,211.57. Coun. Heslop will research with his Broker and ensure that if we change we have like for like insurance which could bring a good saving.
